

COVID-19: Blue Hills Fire Department

July 1, 2021

Please note that these measures may be modified as new information becomes available.

Effective July 1st, the Blue Hills Fire Department has implemented a NEW Protective Face Covering Policy, as follows:

- In accordance with Governor Lamont's Executive Order 12, **fully vaccinated employees and members of the public** are not required to wear a protective face covering while inside Department facilities, except as noted below. A person is considered fully vaccinated 14 days after receiving the final recommended dose of a vaccine approved by the FDA for use against COVID-19.
- Additionally, the Blue Hills Fire Department **may** require fully vaccinated employees and members of the public to wear protective face coverings at specific public events, i.e. events where large crowds are expected and/or unvaccinated people are likely to be in attendance.

Please keep the following in mind before you visit to the Blue Hills Fire Department Offices.

- **Please follow the Governor's Executive Order regarding protective face covering policy.**
- **Unvaccinated employees, volunteers and members of the public will continue to be required to wear a protective face covering while inside the Blue Hills Fire Department.**
- **Please do not come to The Fire Department if you are sick.**
- **Continue to social distance whenever possible.**
